**Annual Neighborhood Yard Sale:** Yes, it's time again for the **Annual Yard Sale** sponsored and supported by your Neighborhood Association. We will place an ad in the Albuquerque Journal as well as placing signs at key entrances to the neighborhood. **The date is Saturday, June 8, start time is 8 a.m.** so be sure to have your sale items out and ready to show by then. She will prepare a list of participants with a map of the neighborhood and make a few copies available to known participants by Saturday morning. We invite you to take advantage of this opportunity to start cleaning out your home, garage, shed and yard.

**Blue Recycle Bins Are Coming:** As you may have heard on the television or read in the newspaper the City is beginning to distribute the blue recycle bins. The processing plant is ready to begin operations and rollout of the 150,000 blue carts is already starting. At the time of this printing our neighborhood is scheduled to receive carts in **August** so hang on to your recycle bags a bit longer. Tuesday will still be our pickup day and the cart should be placed curbside by 7:00 a.m. The list of items suitable for recycling is greatly expanded. **Newspaper, Magazines, Miscellaneous Paper Products:**

All white and colored writing paper, computer paper, magazines, and newspapers including inserts, Junk mail, Corrugated cardboard (the double-walled cardboard with the wiggly center), Cereal / Cracker Boxes, Books (Hard or Soft Covers), Paper Egg Cartons, Soda Boxes, Milk Cartons / Juice boxes, Phone books.

**Tin, Aerosol Cans, or Aluminum Cans:**

Food and pet food cans, Soda and beer cans, Pots and Pans, Small Metal Appliances.

**Plastic:**

All plastic bottles and jugs with a screw top lid or that have a neck smaller than the base, Two liter bottles, Plastic milk jugs, Bleach bottles, Plastics #1 - #7, Rigid Plastics (crates, hampers, toys)

**Electronic Waste (E-Waste):**

Cell Phones, Cameras, Peripherals (Keyboard, mouse, cables), Rechargeable batteries.

**Please do not put these items in your blue cart:**

Hazardous waste, Scrap metal such as metal pipe, hangers, wires, or automotive parts, Hot ashes, Concrete, rocks, gravel, or wood, Pizza boxes, Snack food bags (like chips or popcorn bags), Fast food containers, cups, or wrappers, Styrofoam or styrofoam peanuts, Plastic furniture, Plastic Grocery Bags (Plastic grocery bags can be recycled at your local Smith's or Wal-Mart.), Plastic film, Plastic wrap or dry cleaning bags, Grass, Leaves, Plant trimmings, Tree branches and prunings, Computer Monitors, T.V.'s

**Glass Is Prohibited** - Please DO NOT put glass in your cart. Glass bottles may be taken to any of the 14 clearly labeled glass recycle bins around the city; the nearest is at Smith's Tramway and Montgomery location.
